Contractor's License Number 845438 issued to LAMONA ETEAKI LELENOA DBA A&L CONCRETE CONTRACTORS is revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Section 7102 of the Business and Professions Code and Section 870 of the Code of Regulations, title 16, Respondent **LAMONA ETEAKI LELENOA DBA A&L CONCRETE CONTRACTORS Contractor's** License No **845438**, shall not apply for reissuance or reinstatement of said license for three year(s) from the effective date of this Decision.

Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

This Decision shall become effective on October 25, 2021.

INFORMATION PURSUANT TO §11521 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE

If you wish to file a Petition for Reconsideration pursuant to Government Code §11521, the Petition must be received prior to the effective date of the Decision. However, please be aware that the Contractors State License Board needs approximately five (5) working days to process a Petition. - 11521. (a) The agency itself may order a reconsideration of all or part of the case on its own motion or on petition of any party. The agency shall notify a petitioner of the time limits for petitioning for reconsideration. The power to order a reconsideration shall expire 30 days after the delivery or mailing of a decision to a respondent, or on the date set by the agency itself as the effective date of the decision if that date occurs prior to the expiration of the 30-day period or at the termination of a stay of not to exceed 30 days which the agency may grant for the purpose of filing an application for reconsideration. If additional time is needed to evaluate a petition for reconsideration filed prior to the expiration of any of the applicable periods, an agency may grant a stay of that expiration for no more than 10 days, solely for the purpose of considering the petition. If no action is taken on a petition within the time allowed for ordering reconsideration, the petition shall be deemed denied.
- (b) The case may be reconsidered by the agency itself on all the pertinent parts of the record and such additional evidence and argument as may be permitted, or may be assigned to an administrative law judge. A reconsideration assigned to an administrative law judge shall be subject to the procedure provided in Section 11517. If oral evidence is introduced before the agency itself, no agency member may vote unless he or she heard the evidence.

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24	FINDINGS OF FACT	
25	1. On or about July 30, 2021, Accusation No. N2020-205 was filed against H&L	
26	Concrete Construction with Lamona Eteaki Lelenoa as RMO, CEO and President (Respondent	
27	H&L) and Lamona Eteaki Lelenoa doing business as A&L Concrete Contractors (Respondent	
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Lelenoa) before the Registrar of Contractors (Registrar) for the Contractors' State License Board (Board). (Accusation attached as Exhibit A.)

- 2. On or about September 5, 2018, the Registrar issued Contractor's License No. 1043967 to Respondent H&L. The Contractor's License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. N2020-205 and will expire on September 30, 2022, unless renewed.
- 3. On or about August 26, 2004, the Registrar issued Contractor's License Number 845438 to Respondent Lelenoa doing business as A&L Concrete Contractors. The Contractor's License expired on August 31, 2018, and has not been renewed.
- 4. On or about August 4, 2021, Respondent H&L and Respondent Lelenoa were served by Certified and First Class Mail copies of the Accusation No. N2020-205, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at Respondents' address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 136, is required to be reported and maintained with the Board. Respondents' address of record was and is:

- 5. Service of the Accusation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of Government Code section 11505, subdivision (c) and/or Business & Professions Code section 124.
 - 6. Government Code section 11506(c) states, in pertinent part:
 - (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent files a notice of defense . . . and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts of the accusation . . . not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense . . . shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.
- 7. The Registrar takes official notice of the Board's records and the fact that Respondents failed to file a Notice of Defense within 15 days after service upon them of the Accusation, and therefore waived their right to a hearing on the merits of Accusation No. N2020-205.

evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this case:

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- a. Respondent H&L violated Business and Professions Code (Code) section 7027.4, subdivision (a), in that on the CSB project, its contract advertised as being insured without identifying the type of insurance;
- b. Respondent H&L violated Code section 7027.4, subdivision (b), in that on the CSB project, its contract advertised as being bonded in reference to Contractor's License Number 1043967 issued to H&L Concrete Construction, Inc.
- c. Respondent H&L violated Code section 7107 in that Respondent H&L abandoned the CSB project without legal excuse and without performing extensive work;
- d. Respondent H&L violated Code section 7109, subdivision (a), in that on the CSB project, Respondent H&L willfully departed from accepted trade standards for good and workmanlike construction;
- e. Respondent H&L violated Code section 7113, in that on the CSB project, it failed in a material respect to complete the project for the contract price and the property owner was required to spend a substantial sum in excess of the contract price to complete the project in accordance with the contract;
- f. Respondent H&L violated Code section 7117.6, in that on the CSB project, it contracted for work that required an A-General Engineering Contractor License while only licensed as a C-8 Concrete Contractor;
- g. Respondent H&L violated Code section 7125.4, subdivision (a), in that on the CSB project it employed several persons while failing to maintain Workers' Compensation Insurance for employees;
- h. Respondent H&L violated code section 7117, subdivision (a), in that on the CSB project, it operated in the capacity of a contractor using a namestyle difference from that in which the license was issued;
- i. Respondent Lelenoa violated Code section 7122.5 based on the Code violations by Respondent H&L, for which Respondent Lelenoa was the qualifier.
- 5. Pursuant to its authority under California Government Code section 11520, and based on the relevant evidence before it contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence

Packet, the Registrar hereby finds by clear and convincing evidence that Lamona Eteaki Lelenoa had knowledge of or participated in the prohibited act(s) or omission(s) that warranted the filing of Accusation No. N2020-205.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 7122.5, the performance by an individual, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, firm, or association of an act or omission constituting a cause for disciplinary action constitutes a cause for disciplinary action against a licensee who at the time that the act or omission occurred was the qualifying individual of that individual, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, firm, or association, whether or not he or she had knowledge of or participated in the prohibited act or omission. Therefore, pursuant to section 7122.5, Lamona Eteaki Lelenoa is subject to discipline regardless of whether or not she had knowledge of or participated in the act(s) or omissions(s) in Accusation No. N2020-205.
